## Louisiana House of Representative candidates to speak at SFCA meeting

**Announced candidates** seeking to represent Sherwood Forest in the Louisiana House of Representatives have been invited to speak at the SFCA annual general membership meeting Thursday, Oct. 13. The meeting will begin at 7 p.m. in the St. Thomas More Parish Activity Center, Dartmoor Drive at Goodwood Boulevard.

**Erich Ponti**, incumbent representative in District 69, had no challengers when this newsletter went to press. Announced candidates seeking to represent the newly created District 101 are **Tiffany Foxworth**, **Ted James** and **Harold Williams**. The deadline for candidates to qualify to run in the Oct. 22 primary election is Sept. 8. If a runoff is necessary, the top two candidates will face each other in the general election on Nov. 19. A number of statewide races, including the governorship, also are on the ballot.

**Early voting** for the Oct. 22 primary will take place between 8:30 a.m. and 6 p.m. Oct. 8-15 (except Sunday) at the following locations: the Clerk of Court's office on St. Louis Street downtown (in the Municipal Building), the Clerk of Court's office on Coursey Boulevard, the State Archives Building on Essen Lane, and the Clerk's office in the City of Baker.

**As a result of redistricting**, Sherwood Forest subdivision has been divided roughly in half along Sherwood Forest Boulevard. Residents in Precincts 60 and 72, west of the boulevard, are in **District 69**. Those living east of the boulevard in Precincts 55, 71 and 87 are in **District 101**. To register to vote (by Sept. 21) or find your polling place, call the Registrar of Voters (295-4765) or go to <http://www.sos.louisiana.gov/tabid/457/Default.aspx>.

## **The magic number – 311 – and more!**

You are encouraged to keep your neighborhood neat and clean and your property values high by reporting concerns through the city-parish services paid for by your taxes. To find a governmental agency that can address your concerns, call **311** and speak with a Citizen Services Specialist. The call will create a service request that will automatically be routed to the proper department to deal with things like zoning violations, street and pothole repair, tree branch hazards, loose or nuisance pets, cluttered carports, single-family zoning violations, building violations and many more. These same issues may be submitted online at [www.brgov.com](http://www.brgov.com) (call **273-1353** for help if you have problems using the online method). **MOST IMPORTANTLY, YOU MAY REMAIN ANONYMOUS!**

Call **911** in an emergency. The non-emergency number for City Police is **389-2000**. For suspicious situations that are not time-sensitive call the Sherwood Forest Citizens' Association Security Line, **273-1353**. Leave a call-back message, and include your e-mail for online communication. Specific questions about streets, drainage and sewerage, construction and building codes or the environment should be directed to the Department of Public Works (DPW) at **389-3090, 380-2070**, or online at <http://brgov.com/DEPT/dpw/>.

To report general concerns about the neighborhood, call District 8 Metro Councilman Mike Walker's office at **389-5168** and speak with him or with his legislative assistant, Zona M. Pickens. Councilman Walker's office has recently moved downtown.

## ***Protect your property's value: update deed restrictions***

**Deed restrictions** for six filings are due to renew before the end of 2012.

One of the most effective ways to protect and perhaps enhance your property's value and the quality of life in your neighborhood is to **update your deed restrictions**. This is the method you can use to actually "do something about" some neighborhood problems that have been frustrating you.

If you own a home in one of the following filings, you may contact **Gary Smith** at 273-1353 ([security@sfcabr.org](mailto:security@sfcabr.org)) to learn more about how you can protect your property's value. The entire process takes some time, so we need to get the ball rolling very soon if the filing's homeowners want to take advantage of this great opportunity. (Please tell your neighbors who live in these filings, too.)

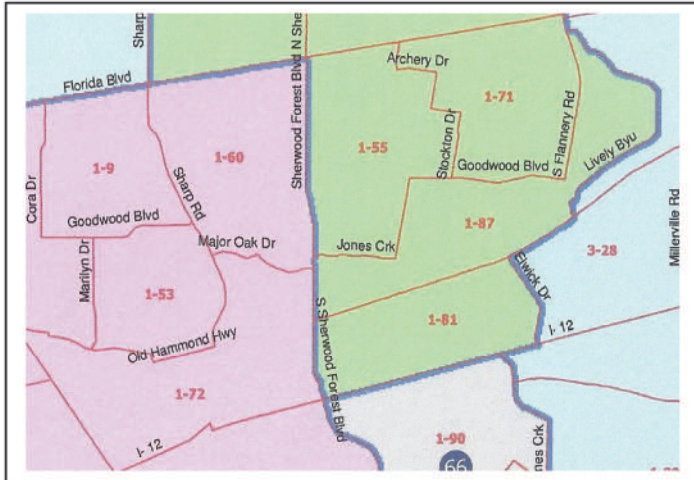

## La. House redistricting divides Sherwood Forest along boulevard



*On the map above, the area in pink shows Sherwood Forest precincts in Louisiana House District 69. The green area shows those in the newly created District 101. The boundaries of Sherwood Forest subdivision are Florida Boulevard, Flannery Road, Old Hammond Highway and Sharp Road. All precincts are in Ward 1. Polling places will not change.*

Before redistricting, Louisiana House of Representatives District 101 was located in New Orleans East, an area devastated by flooding from a levee break after Hurricane Katrina in 2005. Because of population losses in the area, Orleans Parish District 101 was eliminated and its precincts merged into two neighboring districts. The former District 101 was then relocated to East Baton Rouge Parish.

To form the new district, the Louisiana Legislature reassigned portions of Districts 29, 61, 65 and 66 to District 101. Before redistricting, all of Sherwood Forest was in District 66, represented by Hunter Greene, who is term-limited.

Meanwhile, EBR’s District 69, which was overpopulated, released some of its precincts to Districts 66 and 68, then picked up from District 66 precincts in Broadmoor, Cedarcrest, Royal Ascot and the western portion of Sherwood Forest.

### EBR Metro Council Redistricting

Sherwood Forest currently is part of Metro Council District 8, represented by Mike Walker, who is term-limited. According to Zona Pickens, Mr. Walker’s legislative assistant, there currently are two redistricting proposals on the table that would affect Sherwood Forest.

Plan A would place Precincts 55, 60, 71 and 87 in Council District 4. Plan B would place Precincts 55, 71 and 87 in District 4 and Precinct 60 in District 6. New council representatives will be elected from each district once redistricting is complete and an election date is scheduled.

These proposed plans are subject to change, Zona said. There also is the possibility that an entirely new plan, or several new plans, could be introduced for consideration by the Metro Council. **However, a final plan must be adopted no later than Dec. 31, 2011.**

To offer input about these or any other redistricting proposals, **call Zona or Mike at 389-5168 before the end of the year.** Note that this is a new phone number since the district office is now located downtown. Typical rehabilitation repairs include pipe and manhole replacement and trenchless technologies that minimize above-ground disturbances, such as cured in-place pipe liners.
- B) **Capacity** projects are typically less intrusive to homeowner's property.
  - o Activities in the **Design Phase** include: Surveying and Inspections via smoke testing and CCTV.
- C) When an activity is done within a particular area, residents will be notified:
  - o CIPP (Yellow Flyer): Residents are asked to limit major water use, such as washing clothes or dishes, taking baths, flushing toilets when possible. Notice given between 48 and 24 hours.
  - o Inspections (Hot Pink Flyer): If your property must be accessed you will be contacted.
  - o Street Closures (Florescent Orange).
  - o Work is beginning (Florescent Green): Work will begin within 7 days.


