PARISH OF EAST BATON ROUGE

HEFORE ME, the undereigned authority, duly commissioned and qualified in end for the Parish and State aforesaid, and in the presence of the undersigned competent witnesses, personally came and appeared HOLF T. HARRISON, married to and living with Elmira Harelson, a resident of lawful age of the Parish of East Baton Rouge, Louisiana, who, after being duly sworn, did declare that he is the owner of thirty-six (36) lots or parcels of ground, bearing numbers one (1) through thirty-six (36), inclusive, and being designated on the final plat of West Sherwood Forest Subdivision, and being the subdivision of a portion of the Holt T. Harrison property in Section 12, Township 7 South, Range 1 East, Greensburg Land District of Louisiana, Parish of East Beton Rouge, Louisiana, said subdivision having been laid out by Edward E. Evans, C.B., and dated Baton Rouge, Louisiana, May 12, 1956, a copy of which is attached hereto and made a part hereof, and which said plat is paraphed "He Varietur" by me, said Rotary, for identification herewith.

Appearer further declared that he has established and does hereby establic, certain building restrictions and conditions for the benefit of said property to be binding upon and enforceable by the present or future owners of said lots, it being the intention of appearer to establish these restrictions as sarvitudes and covenants running with the laud and applicable to each of the above described and numbered lots, said restrictions being set out as follows, to-wit:

- 1. Except as hereinafter provided, all of the lots contained in this subdivision are hereby designated as residential lots, and no building shell be erected, altered, placed or permitted to remain on any lots other than one (1) detached single family dwelling not to exceed two and one-half stories in height and a private garage for not more than three (3) cars.
- 2. No building shall be erected, placed, or altered on any lot until the construction plans and specifications and a plan showing the location of the structure have been approved by the architectural control committee as to quality of workmanship and materials, harmony of external design with existing structures, and as to location with respect to topography and fluish grade elevation. The fence or wall shall be erected, placed or eltered on any lot hearer to any street that the minimum building setback line unless similarly approved.
- 3. The minimum requirements for residential structures is set out as follows: (a) For single-story residence 1250 square feet of living area. The minimum requirements for the horizontal reof eras shall be 1750 square feet.
- (b) For two-story residence 1800 square feet total of living area with a minimum of 1250 square feet of living area on the

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ground floor. The minimum roof area shall be 1750 square foot.

The above set out living areas are exclusive of open porches and carports or garages. The above set out roof areas are inclusive of porch, carport and/or garage roofs.

4. So building shall be located on any lot nearer to the front lot line than forty (h0) feet, nor nearer to the side property line than ten (10) feet. Garages and carports may be attached to main dwelling but must not be nearer to the side property line than five (5) feet. For the purposes of this covenant, saves, steps and open porches shall not be considered as part of a building. A maximum building set-back line of sixty (60) feet is hereby authorized. Detached garages and/or accessory buildings shall not be erected closer than five (5) feet to any sideline or closer than ten (10) feet to rear lot line.

- 5. Essements for installation and maintenance of utilities and drainage facilities are reserved as shown on the recorded plat.
- 6. No norious or offensive activity shall be carried on upon any lot, nor shall anything be done thereon which may become an analogance or nuisance to the neighborhood.
- 7. These covenants prohibit the resubdivision of lots from any dimensions other than those shown on the official recorded plat, however, this does not prohibit the use of more than one (1) lot for one (1) residence.

8. No garage apartments are to be srected or to be used as residence except as a residence for domestic servants to the occupants of the main residential premises.

9. No structure of a temporary character, trailer, basement, tent, shack, garage, barn or other outbuildingshall be used on any lot at at, time as a residence eacher temporarily or permenently.

10. No livestock shall be kept on said premises.

11. We fence shall be eracted on said lot beyond the front building setback line of that lot, nor pearer any streat than farty (40) feet.

12. No building or structure shall be constructed using imitation brick, imitation stone or esbestos on the exterior. Residences shall be constructed with exteriors predominantly of mesonry or mesonry veneer. Residences proposed to be constructed with exteriors of materials other than the above are subject to disapproval by the Architectural control committee when such use of materials in their opinion is not reasonably harmonious with the surrounding structures.

13. An Architectural control committee composed of George R. Thompson, L. P. Manson, Bolt T. Harrison, Frank DeFrancis, Reymond Post, W. Benton Harelson, Walker Lloyd, Jim Saith and W. B. Jones is hereby appointed. A majority of the Committee may designate a representative to act for it. In the event of death or resignation of any member of the committee, the remaining massers shall have full authority to designate a successor. Feither the members of the committee, nor its designated representative shall be entitled to any compensation for services performed pursuant to this covenant. At any time, the then record owners of amajority of the lots shall have the power through a duly recorded the instrument to change the membership of the committee or to the power and duty.

14. The committed royal or disapproval as required in these covenants shall be relating. In the event the consists or its designated representative, fails to approve or disapprova within 30 days after plans and specifications have been substituted to it, or in any order, if require to enjoin the construction has been commenced prior to the implation thereof, approval will not be required and the relationcovenants shall be deemed to have fully

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complied with.

- 7. These covenants prohibit the resubdivision of lots from any dimensions other than those shown on the official recorded plat, however, this does not prohibit the use of more than one (1) lot for one (1) residence.

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- .8. No garage apartments are to be erected or to be used as residence except as a residence for domestic servants to the occupants of the main residential premises.
- 9. No structure of a temporary character, trailer, basement, tent, shack, garage, barn or other outbuilding shall be used on any lot at any time as a residence excher temporarily or permanently.
